The Douglas County Department of Public Works Engineering, in cooperation with the Colorado Department of Transportation, is embarking on updating a long-range planning study for the US85 corridor from approximately .5 miles north of C-470 to State Highway 67 in Sedalia, Colorado, as well as near-term capacity/widening improvements on the corridor from Blakeland Drive to Highlands Ranch Parkway. The studies and improvements are addressing continued growth in northwest Douglas County and the need for evaluating transportation improvements to support this growth in the year 2040 and beyond. Douglas County has selected HDR Engineering ("HDR") as their consultant to assist them with this process. HDR and their sub consultants will begin this study by conducting land and environmental surveys of the study area. The purpose of the land survey, which will be performed by Woolpert, Inc., is to set temporary survey control panels to perform aerial photography that will be used as the basis for project studies. The panels act as markers allowing the surveyor to adjust the aerial photos for accurate and measurable mapping. The purpose of the environmental survey is to identify the presence of archaeological, historical, paleontological or ecological resources, and possibly perform noise or air quality measurements.
